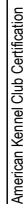

From the North: I-35 south to CR-2 exit, EXIT 131, toward US-8/FOREST LAKE. Turn RIGHT onto W BROADWAY AVE/CR-2 W and go 6.9 miles. Turn LEFT onto LEXINGTON AVE NE/CR-17/CR-18 and continue for 4.8 miles. Turn RIGHT onto BUNKER LAKE BLVD NE/CR-116 W, for 3.5 miles. Turn RIGHT onto ABERDEEN ST NE for 1 block. Facility is on the right.

From the South: I-35W north. Merge onto US-10 W via EXIT 30 toward ANOKA for 2.8 miles. EXIT on HWY 65 (Central Ave) and turn RIGHT traveling for 6.1 miles. Turn RIGHT at BUNKER LAKE BLVD. Turn LEFT on ABERDEEN ST. NE for 1 block. Facility is on the right.

From the East: Take I-94 to I-35W NORTH. Merge onto US-10 W via EXIT 30 toward ANOKA for 2.8 miles. EXIT on HWY 65 (Central Ave) and turn RIGHT traveling for 6.1 miles. Turn RIGHT at BUNKER LAKE BLVD. Turn LEFT on ABERDEEN ST. NE for 1 block. Facility is on the right.

From St Cloud: Take Hwy 10 EAST 49 miles. Take the CR-14/MAIN ST exit, turn LEFT. Turn LEFT onto COON CREEK BLVD NW/CR-18 N for 1.6 miles. Turn RIGHT on BUNKER LAKE BLVD and travel 4.7 miles. Turn LEFT on ABERDEEN ST NE for 1 block. Facility is on your right.

Information For Exhibitors

Information For Exhibitors Cont.

Food: Food will not be available for workers only at these trials. There are several restaurants around the show site.

Obstacles: Obstacles will conform to current requirements of the Regulations for Agility Trials.

Warm-Ups: A warm-up area consisting of a regulation agility jump will be provided for all exhibitors.

Ringside: Dogs are not required to be at the trial until the scheduled time of judging. All dogs not needed for further judging are excused. The owner/handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when the class is to be judged. Please help your fellow competitors, the trial workers, and the judge by checking in with the gate steward well ahead of your run, and being prompt at the line when your turn comes to run.

Dogs Eligible to Enter: As it states in the Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 1, Section 3, All dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate except bitches in heat, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Dogs or register able breeds with accepted foreign registration numbers are eligible to participate.

Height Divisions: Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division.

Regular Titling Classes:

8 Inches—For Dogs 11 Inches and under at the withers.
12 Inches—For Dogs 14 Inches and under at the withers.
16 Inches—For Dogs 18 Inches and under at the withers.
20 Inches—For Dogs 22 Inches and under at the withers.
24 Inches—For Dogs over 22 Inches at the withers.
26 Inches—May Be Entered at Owner's discretion.

Preferred Titling Classes:

4 Inches—For Dogs 11 Inches and under at the withers.
8 Inches—For Dogs 14 Inches and under at the withers.
12 Inches—For Dogs 18 Inches and under at the withers.
16 Inches—For Dogs 22 Inches and under at the withers.
20 Inches—For Dogs over 22 Inches at the withers.

Prize and Awards: Ribbons will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place dogs in each Standard and Jumpers with Weaves class. A green qualifying ribbon will be awarded to all dogs earning a qualifying score. A MACH/PACH bar and Rosette will be awarded to each team earning MACH/PACH. The club reserves the right to substitute prizes of equal or greater value. All awards and prizes must be claimed at the show as none will be mailed.

Refunds: Entry fees for bitches that come into season and injured dogs after the closing date will be refunded with a veterinary note presented to the trial secretary (minus \$15.00 administration fee per day). Request for refunds must be made prior to the start of judging. No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by vet or judge, or barred from competition by action of the trial committee.

Safety/Behavior: The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rule and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. All dogs present must be on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when using the warm-up jump.

Liability: It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitors whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Twin Cities Lhasa Apso Club, On The Run! Canine Center, and its agents, employees, ect. will not assume responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

Crating: No Ex-pens allowed. Crates may be left overnight; however Twin Cities Lhasa Apso Club and On the Run! Canine Center will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

Entry Fees: Exhibitors must submit entries with checks drawn on US accounts or with international money orders payable in US funds.

Online Entries

This trial is accepting online entries through LabTestedOnline.com. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper will be as follows. 165 runs online (50%), 165 runs paper (50%) each day. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular tiling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners SM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?

Best Practices – Agility Trials

Below is a list of Best Practices for the Twin Cities Lhasa Apso Club AKC Agility Trial to comply with the CDC and AKC Guidelines. We are committed to providing a safe environment for our exhibitors, workers, and judges. With that, below are some guidelines we will be following.

Building Limits: To comply with the State of MN, the maximum capacity of the building is 55 people. Please do not bring additional people to this trial. We will be counting throughout the day to make sure we are in compliant. If we reach our limit, it will be a one-in-one-out situation.

Crating: Limited crating will be available inside the building. To stay within the required building limits, only exhibitors queuing up to for their scheduled times should be in the building. Please do not bring unentered dogs to the trial. Please note: On The Run Canine Center will be disinfecting the facility down each night after the trial. If you would like, you can bring a cover to drape over your crates to cover anything that you do not want sprayed. The Twin Cities Lhasa Apso Club and On The Run Canine Center are not responsible for any damages.

Trial Logistics:

Masks/Face Coverings: The CDC recommends that masks are worn when in close proximity to others. Please be sure to adhere to CDC recommendations in order to make the trial as safe as possible. In addition, volunteers will be required to wear a mask while working. **Exhibitors will be required to wear a face covering during your run. Face Shields: For the safety of others, face shields with a open bottom design and not worn with a mask, need to have the open area modified with something that catches droplets. It can be as simple as a bandana taped to the shield bottom edge and tied back around neck.**

Check-In: The Agility Gate App will be used at this trial. The app is available to download for both iOS and Android. We will be using this app and it will be projected on a TV by the gate entrance. You will still be able to check in if you do not have your own device, but it is highly recommended to use your device to reduce crowding by the gate.

Posting/Results Sheet: Results will be posted online at the Xtreme K9 website. **Course Maps:** Course maps will be posted, emailed to the exhibitors the night before, as well as posted on the Xtreme K9 website. Please plan on taking pictures of the maps. If you cannot take a picture of the maps, a limited supply of paper maps will be available.

Entry/Exit Gates: NanoSeptic Covers have been placed on the gate. Please touch this area when opening the gate, as it self-cleans itself. When lining up to go into the ring for your run, please allow 6 ft between each other.

Walk-Throughs: To be determined based on entries at time of closing. Decisions will be made to provide enough social distance on course between exhibitors. Per AKC's suggestions, walk-thoughts will be limited to a maximum of 25 exhibitors.

Running/Walk-Through Times: After closing, a timeline will be put together for the trial. Walk-Through times are estimates, however, Novice/Open will not start before the published time.

Leashes: There are two options:

Option 1: The Leash Runner will use a "grabber" to move your leash to the end of the course. Your leash will be placed on the ground. The "grabber" will be wiped down each time it's used.

Option 2: You can place your leash in your pocket, around your neck, or around your waist per AKC.

If the dog grabs the leash while running, this will be scored as an "E".

The next dog will not enter the ring until the previous dog is leashed up.

Briefing: General briefing will occur in the ring. Please gather, using proper social distancing, outside and inside ring.

Ribbons/Awards: Ribbons will be placed on the table. Please use the provided hand sanitizer to sanitize before touching the labels. Please sanitize before and after.

Food: Food will not be served at the trial. Please plan accordingly. As per AKC guidelines, no MACH/PACH cakes are allowed at the trial.

Communication: During the trial, we understand that people will be spread out and not know what is happening by the ring. After the trial closes, confirmed exhibitors will receive information via email on how to "opt-in" for updates throughout the trial via mass text messaging. A Facebook live feed will also be accessible during this trial. Instructions will be sent out to confirmed exhibitors.

The Twin Cities Lhasa Apso Club reserves the right to make alterations to the guidelines stated above to better/improve the trial.

Class Changes Effective January 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Entering for Exhibition Only (FEO)

FEO allows exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only offered in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring. Toys must be non-audible and may not leave the handlers hand. Toys that roll freely may not be used.
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

Fix and Go On

Fix and Go On allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using Fix and Go On will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the run.
